<u>CoffeeTech Industries to Build New \$56</u> <u>Million Headquarters and Manufacturing</u> <u>Facility in Seguin, Texas</u>



The Seguin Economic Development Corporation (SEDC), the City of Seguin, and Guadalupe County announced today that Coffee Tech Industries (CTI) will build its new 112,000 square foot state-of-the-art headquarters and manufacturing facility in Seguin, Texas. Coffee Tech Industries will build on a 33-acre site situated between 8th Street and Guadalupe Street, just south of Interstate 10. The project will represent a total capital investment of at least \$56 million and will result in the creation of at least 91 new jobs. **Read more**


Area businesses help hospital's effort to fight COVID

Texas Gov. Greg Abbott's mandatory order requiring individuals to wear face mask for all counties in the state of Texas that currently have more than 20 cases of COVID-19 continues today as people return to work and other daily priorities.

<u>GRMC achieves Healthgrades Outstanding</u> <u>Patient Experience Award for the Third Year</u> <u>in a Row (2018-2020)</u>

(Seguin) — Guadalupe Regional Medical Center (GRMC) has announced that it has achieved the Healthgrades 2020 Outstanding Patient Experience Award™. This

distinction recognizes GRMC as being among the top 5 percent percent of hospitals nationwide for patient experience, according to Healthgrades, the leading resource that connects consumers, physicians and health systems.

Healthgrades evaluated 3,346 hospitals that submitted at least 100 patient experience surveys to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), covering admissions from April 2018 through March 2019, to identify hospital performance. Of those hospitals evaluated, 424 hospitals outperformed their peersbased on their patients' responses-to achieve this distinction. **Read More**

San Antonio Economic Indicators

The San Antonio Business-Cycle Index grew at a record pace after a severe contraction in the prior two months. The local unemployment rate declined, and net jobs increased in May, although the level of jobs remained significantly below February. Local consumer spending has improved significantly since mid-April but remains below pre-COVID-19 levels. May home sales improved slightly, and stock prices of San Antonio-based companies increased for the majority of June. **Read More**

Texas Manufacturing Outlook Survey

Texas factory activity rebounded strongly in June, according to business executives responding to the Texas Manufacturing Outlook Survey. The production index, a key measure of state manufacturing conditions, climbed from -28.0 to 13.6, indicating moderate expansion in output following three months of record or near-record declines. **Read More**
