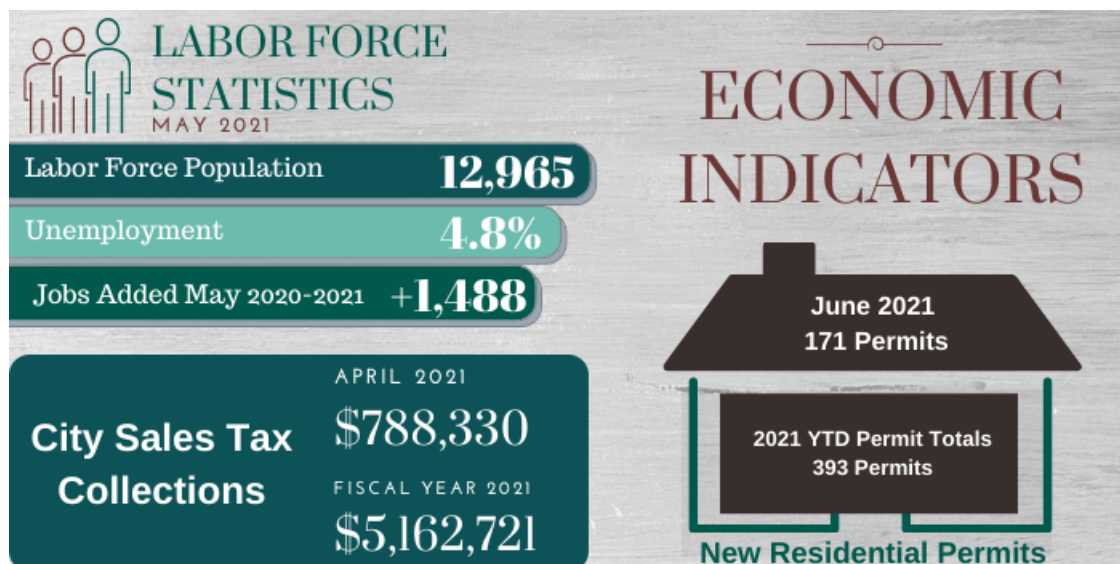
**SEDC Announced as Recipient of the 2021
