

Texas factory activity continued to increase in October, albeit at a slightly slower pace, according to business executives responding to the Texas Manufacturing Outlook Survey. The production index, a key measure of state manufacturing conditions, fell six points to 18.3. The reading was still well above average and indicative of solid output growth. **Read More**

San Antonio Economic Indicators

Broad measures of the San Antonio economy were largely positive in September. Payrolls surged in the month, though jobs in the third quarter posted tepid growth. The unemployment rate was steady. The San Antonio Business-Cycle Index increased in September after declining in August. Recent consumer spending remained above pre-COVID-19 levels. Home sales improved after three months of contraction, and COVID-19 hospitalizations continued to decline after peaking in late August. **Read More**
