Texas Manufacturing Growth Abates, Outlooks Worsen

Growth in Texas factory activity decelerated sharply in June, according to business executives responding to the Texas Manufacturing Outlook Survey. The production index, a key measure of state manufacturing conditions, fell from 18.8 to 2.3, reaching its lowest reading since May 2020. **Read More**

San Antonio Economic Indicators

Broad measures of the San Antonio economy remained positive in May, though

some indicators suggested a moderation in activity. The San Antonio Business-Cycle Index rose despite an increase in the metro unemployment rate. Annualized net job growth over the three months ending in May remained positive. Wages in San Antonio ticked up, with the metro's wage growth outpacing both the state and national averages over the past 12 months. Local consumer spending and dining-out activity slowed in June but were above prepandemic levels. **Read More**
