
presented on Thursday, June 22nd, during the TEDC's 2023 Mid-Year Conference in Allen, Texas. **Read More**

SEGUIN ISD BOARD OKS RAISES FOR STAFF

Seguin ISD staff will see a bump in pay as the district attempts to keep employees from leaving for other districts or career opportunities. Much like the rest of the state, Seguin ISD is seeing teachers opting to take jobs closer to home or even out of education. In an effort to reduce the amount of staffing changes, the board voted unanimously on Tuesday to give teachers, clerical, maintenance, custodial and

transportation a 4% raise, campus administration and other professionals a 3.5% and child nutrition staff a \$1.50 an hour raise. **Read More**
